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This is a SOCP meeting. However, the Coast Guard is onboard to answer questions about the STCW95 Code Amendments and the methodology to use for developing assessment criteria. They cannot comment on any ongoing rule-making issues. Ms. Rachel Wallace, from the Coast Guard Legal Office, will be onboard to address any legal issues.

The results of the working groups will be forwarded to MARAD and the Coast Guard. SOCP also intends to forward the recommendation to MERPAC (when its charter is renewed) for their official endorsement. If requested, SOCP will provide additional comment at the December 8-9, 2010 meeting at MITAGS.

Instructions to the Working Group Chairs and Attendees

1. Please bring 3 hard copies and an electronic version of the assigned table(s). We ask that all attendees bring their own hard copies to minimize the copying. You may also want to bring a hard copy of the existing STCW95Code for reference.
2. Please bring a laptop and projector. (MITAGS can provide a projector if needed.) Assign a person within the group to edit the tables. We recommend that you project the table on the screen and edit each assessment as a group. Start working on the *“italicized”* assessment first. (They are the amended or new assessments.) If time permits, you are welcome to go back and provide comments on the existing assessment.
3. When editing the tables, please use the ~~strike-through~~ feature of Word to indicate text to be removed. **USE SMALL CAPS FONTS FOR NEW TEXT AND HIGHLIGHT IN YELLOW.** Also, add a cover page to the beginning of the tables to provide general comments, and the members of your group. It would also be helpful to provide an e-mail address in case SOCP or the Coast Guard has any questions on your recommendation.
4. We **cannot** change the tables' "Competencies, Knowledge, Understanding, or Proficiency. " This information comes directly from the STCW95 Code or the recent Manila Amendments. The Coast Guard is looking for guidance on developing the "**Performance Condition,**" "**Performance Behavior,**" and "**Performance Standard**" for each competence. Some tables already have this information included. You are welcome to provide additional comments, recommendations or modifications to the existing ones.
